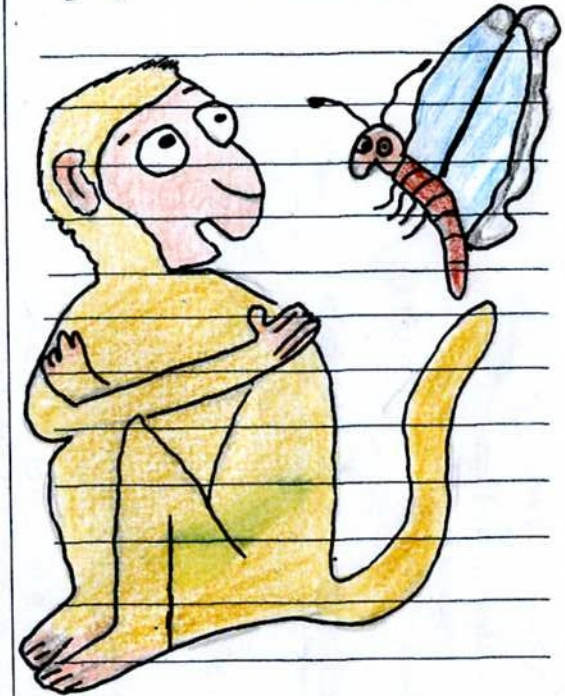
A brief synopsis... A young monkey has lost his Mum and a helpful butterfly tries to help him find her. However things do not go to plan.
